Terms and conditions of Authorization :-

- 1. Authorization to operate is granted for period of **Five Years** from date of issue of this letter.
- 2. The authorization shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, and the rules made there under.
- 3. The authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorized by the concerned State Pollution Control Board.
- 4. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment as working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of his authorization.
- 5. It is the duty of the authorized person to take prior permission of the concerned State Pollution Control Board to close down the operations.
- 6. An application for the renewal of an authorization shall be made as laid down in sub-rule (vi) of rule 13(2).

The Authorization for Dismantling, Recycling and Collection of E-Waste for the Capacity of 6000 MT/Year:-

- 7. Industry shall ensure that no damage is caused to the Environment during storage and transportation of e-waste.
- 8. Industry shall ensure that the facilities and dismantling process are in accordance with the standards of guidelines published by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time.
- 9. Industry shall not install any furnace in the premises.
- 10. Industry shall ensure that the recycling processes do not have any adverse effect on the health and the environment;
- 11. Industry shall make available all records to the Central Pollution Control Board or the concerned State Pollution Control Board for inspection;
- 12. Industry shall ensure that the fractions or material not recycled in its facility is sent to the respective authorised recyclers;
- 13. Industry shall ensure that residue generated during recycling process is disposed of in an authorised treatment storage disposal facility;
- 14. Industry shall maintain record of e-waste collected, dismantled, recycled and sent to authorized recycler in Form-2 and make Such record available for scrutiny by the Central Pollution Control Board or the concerned State Pollution Control Board;
- 15. The Industry shall maintain records of the e-waste purchased, processed in Form-2 and shall file annual returns of its activities of previous year in Form-3 as per Rules 11 (9) & 13 (3)(vii) of the E-Waste (M) Rules, 2016, on or before 30 th june every year.

16. Board reserves the right to cancel/amend the above condition and add new conditions as and when deemed necessary.
